When she searches "abortion near me," she sees ads offering to pay her travel expenses or send her abortion pills by mail for as little as \$29.

#### **Extended Evening Hours**

The center is now open until 8:00 PM on Tuesdays, with the expectation to add another evening in 2025.

### **30 volunteers**

# **POST-ABORTION SUPPORT GROUPS**

4 facilitators were trained to lead abortion recovery groups using the Forgiven and Set Free group study. In 2024, FWPC hosted a group in person and a group online.

8 participants found support through community, the peace in God's forgiveness and took steps toward healing and wholeness available through Jesus Christ.

# PREPARING PARENTS AND WELCOMING BABIES

Setting up young parents for success takes a village. Our hearts overflow with gratitude to those who gave of their time, treasure and talents to bless clients in practical ways and reflect the love of Jesus to them. Friends of the center give in abundance to empower young women and men to choose life.

- 23 Earned baby showers upon class completion



## **TWO CHURCHES, TWO LIVES TRANSFORMED**

#### **BEATRIZ**



While Beatriz was meeting with her advocate, her partner was in the lobby booking her an abortion appointment in Kansas. She told us that she didn't want to have an abortion, but with her financial challenges and lack of support, she felt she had no choice.

When she saw her baby on the sonogram, Beatriz told us that she wanted to have her baby, but she needed a lot of help. **We connected Beatriz with a small, local church and they became God's answer for her situation.** There, Beatriz found community, heard the Gospel, got baptized and encountered the love of a Savior who has provided for her every need.

#### VICTORIA

Victoria was also facing a lack of resources and support for her pregnancy. The father of the baby was pressuring her to abort. Unlike Beatriz, Victoria was overcome by fear and had an abortion. Afterward, she was emotionally devastated. Like Beatriz, the local church became the hands and feet of Jesus in her life. There, Victoria encountered community, compassion and the healing and forgiveness of the Lord.

#### **PRAYER WARRIORS**

The real-time support from faithful prayer warriors makes all the difference in the lives of women and men facing urgent pregnancy decisions. Prayer partners stand in the gap and intercede on behalf of the unborn.

**32** Prayer Partner emails were sent with an average of **1375** people opening to read each one.

119 unique individuals were prayed for

22 "praise reports" with known answer to prayers were included
